## Conditions for eligibility:

- 1. The applicant must be a citizen of India or an Overseas Citizen of India, and must have been; (a) born in Goa on or before 19th December, 1961, or, (b) born of a parent who resided in Goa on or before 19th December, 1961, or, (c) born in Goa and a resident of State of Goa continuously for the last thirty years, or, (d) resident of State of Goa for the last thirty years, or, (e) born in Goa of parents who have been residents of the State of Goa for the last thirty years, on the date of making application for the tenement. Provided that where the applicant is an Overseas Citizen of India, he shall obtain clearance of competent regulatory authorities prior to making the application.
- 2. The applicant shall fill in only one e-application in Form-II or Form-II(A), either in his/her own name or in the name of any other member of his/her family.
- 3. The individual, society, firm or company applying for a tenement to be used for commercial purpose, he/or it shall not own a commercial tenement already allotted by the Board in his or its name or in the name of his family and purchased by him or it within 30 years immediately prior to the date of application anywhere in the State of Goa and an affidavit to this effect shall be produced in Form-I(A).
- 4. An institution, society, firm or company may apply for a tenement to be used for commercial purpose, with a valid registration certificate issued by the competent

- authority, five years prior to the date of making of an application in Form-II(A). Only one such application from each such entity shall be entertained. An individual may also apply for a tenement to be used for commercial purpose in Form-II(A).
- 5. The applicant should have attained the age of eighteen years at the time of making an application.
- 6. The applicants shall submit the self attested copies of the documents including proof of birth (of the applicant/parent, as the case may be), income certificate, residence certificate (of the applicant/parent, as the case may be) issued by competent authority, PAN card, Aadhaar Card, original affidavit in FORM-I or FORM-I(A), as the case may be and bank details (for refund) to the Goa Housing Board office at Porvorim on or before 20/02/2024 for scrutiny.
- 7. If an applicant withdraws from the scheme after depositing initial deposit, 5% of the deposit shall be forfeited to the Board and the balance amount shall be refunded to the applicant without any interest.
- Date and time to participate in e-auction and procedure of e-auction will be intimated to the eligible applicants.
- All eligible applicants shall compulsorily participate in the 'e auction trial run' conducted live. The schedule of the same shall be intimated.
- 10. There shall be atleast 2 applicant bidders present for the auction/E-auction proceedings for each tenement, failing which, the bidding shall defer.
- 11. The Managing Director of the Board may postpone/cancel/defer the auction/E-auction proceedings of any particular tenement/tenements, as the case may be, at any time without assigning reasons thereof.
- 12. The decision of the Managing Director of the Board in the matter of allotment of tenement by auction/E-auction to the highest bidder shall be final and binding on the allottees and no appeal thereon shall be entertained.
- 13. Tenements offered shall be on "as is where is basis" and the allottee shall not have any right to complain or raise any objection about nature, condition or planning etc., or to claim any damage or compensation on any account from the Board.
- 14. The allottee shall pay the full consideration of the tenement allotted within a period of 60 days of receipt of the order of allotment, failing which, the order of allotment shall stand cancelled without any further notice and 5% of the initial deposit of the applicant shall be forfeited to the Board and the balance amount shall be refunded to the applicant without any interest.
- 15. The allotment of tenements shall be in accordance with the Goa Housing Board (Registration, Allotment and Sale of Tenements) Rules, 2016 and amendments thereon.
